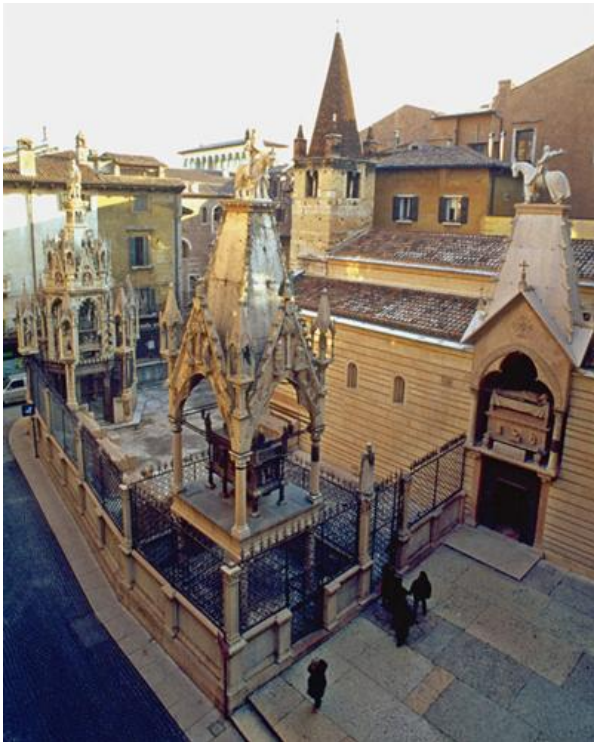


Scaligeri Tombs



The Scaligeri's tombs situated in the inner city of Verona, are monumental complex in Gothic style of the Scaliger family. It contains the tombs of some of the famous representatives family members, among whom, the greatest lord of Verona: Cangrande. The tombs were made in the 14th century by various sculptors. They are considered the most important example of Gothic art in Verona.

Nonetheless towards the end of the 16th century the tombs already showed signs of degradation caused by a state of semi-abandon. A complete restoration of the tombs of Mastino was done in 1786, whereas a general restoration of the monumental complex was done recently.

Our association "Legambiente" that safeguards minor artistic works, opens these tombs to tourists during the summer.
